Rogue Jazz Guy Ale is tawny amber in color with a coffee aroma and tight head. A delicate roasted malt accent, generous use of hops and a smooth finish. It is created using Northwest Harrington Klages, 95-115 and 315-165 Crystal Malts, Kent Golding and Cascade Hops.

Celebrating its second century, Rogue Ales is an Artisan Varietal Brewery founded in Oregon in 1988, as one of America's first 50 microbreweries. Rogue has 550+ awards for taste and quality and is distributed nationally and in 9 other countries.
