Rogue Spirits win 6 medals

GENEVA, Switzerland, February 16, 2009 – Rogue Spirits was the most honored distillery at the **World Beverage Competition**, winning six medals in competition with the top distillers from 25 countries in “The Largest Beverage Competition in the World.” All spirits in the World Beverage Competition are judged by a panel of industry experts in the blind tasting method. Other participants included Tanqueray, Bacardi, and Svedka.

Rogue’s Rum, Gins and Whiskey won two **Gold** Medals, three **Silvers** and one **Bronze** Medal.

Rogue’s **Spruce Gin** was named the **BEST AMERICAN GIN**, edging out Rogue’s Pink Gin for the **Gold** Medal.

Hazelnut Spice Rum took **Gold** in the spiced rum category.

Dead Guy Whiskey won a **Silver** Medal in the whiskey competition.

Rogue’s **Dark Rum** won a **Silver** Medal in the dark rum category.

Vintage Vodka was the **Bronze** medal winner in the vodka category.
